
Individual-Investor Assets Composition



Individual investors held Rs.10.67 lakh crore in mutual funds as of October 2017, an increase of 39.4% over October 2016.

Investments of individual investors in equity schemes increased by 52% over October 2016.



Figures in Rs crores. Individual-investor assets considered here include investments by HNIs. Equity-oriented schemes include equity and balanced funds.


Individual Investors – Overall Composition

62% of the assets of Individual investors are from T15 cities, brought in by distributors.


Direct investments amount to 14% of individual assets, divided as 2% from B15 and 12% from T15.







Individual Investors – Scheme level Composition
