
## **Individual-Investor Assets Composition**



Individual investors held Rs.9.17 lakh crore in mutual funds as of May 2017, an increase of 39.5% over May 2016.

Investments of individual investors in equity schemes increased by 52.04% over May 2016.



Figures in Rs crores. Individual-investor assets considered here include investments by HNIs. Equity-oriented schemes include equity and balanced funds.


## **Individual Investors – Overall Composition**

63% of the assets of Individual investors are from T15 cities, brought in by distributors.


Direct investments amount to 13% of individual assets, divided as 2% from B15 and 11% from T15.







## **Individual Investors – Scheme level Composition**
