
Individual-Investor Assets Composition

Figures in Rs crores. Individual-investor assets considered here include investments by HNIs. Equity-oriented schemes include equity and balanced funds.


Individual Investors – Overall Composition

64% of the assets of Individual investors are from T30 cities, brought in by distributors.


Direct investments amount to 16% of individual assets, divided as 2% from B30 and 14% from T30.







Individual Investors – Scheme level Composition
