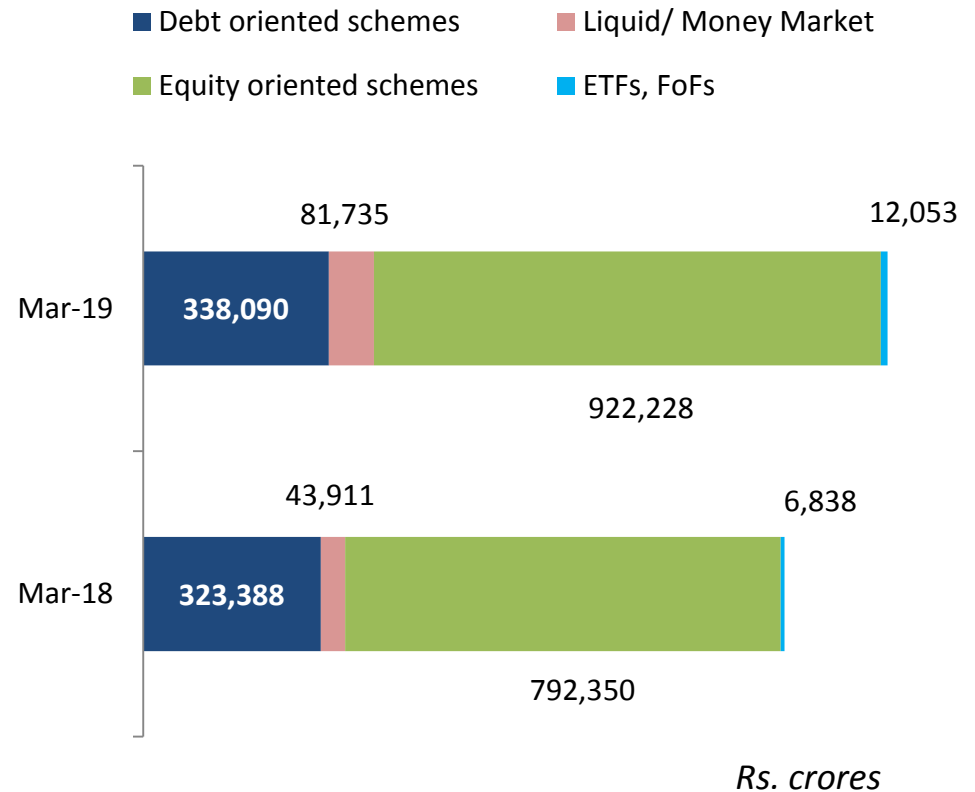


Individual-Investor Assets Composition



Individual investors held Rs.13.54 lakh crore in mutual funds as of March 2019, an increase of 16.08% over March 2018.

Investments of individual investors in equity schemes increased by 16.39% over March 2018.

Equity-oriented schemes include equity and balanced funds.*

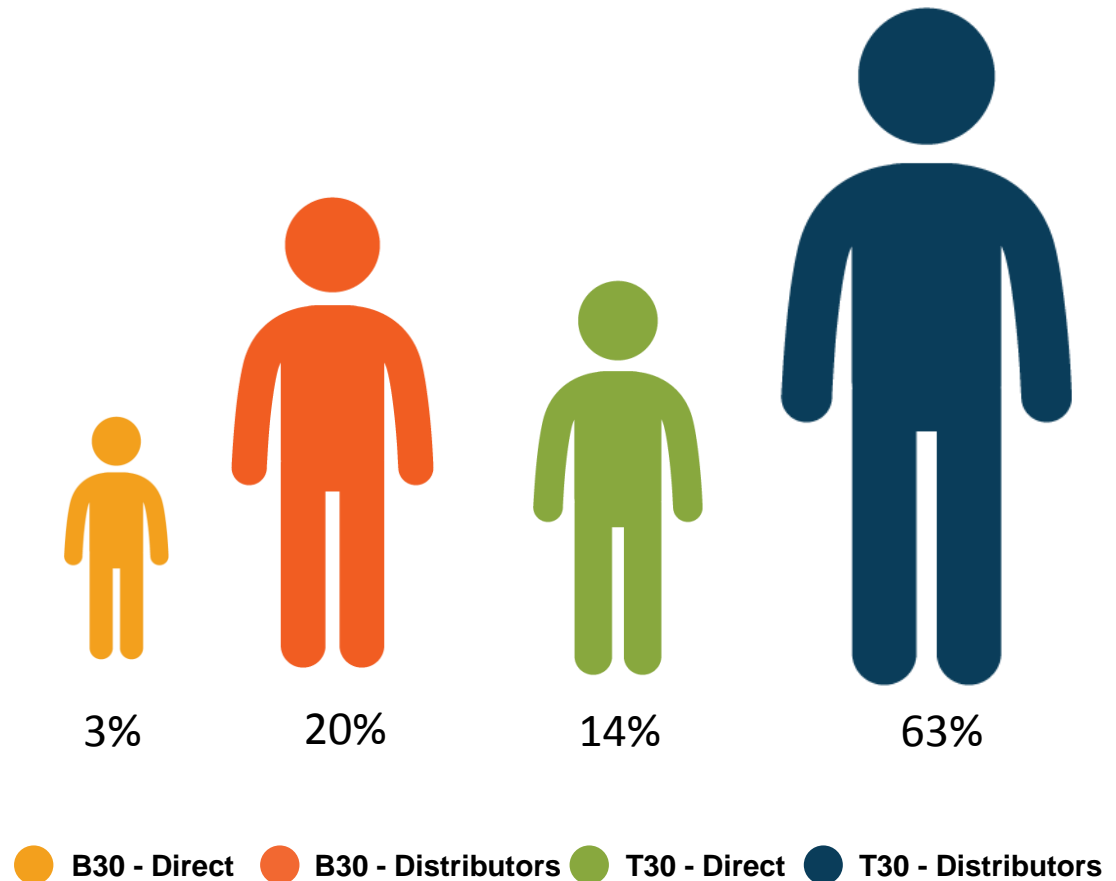
Individual Investors – Overall Composition



Individual assets have mainly come from the top 30 locations, and are primarily distributor-driven.

63% of the assets of Individual investors are from T30 cities, brought in by distributors.

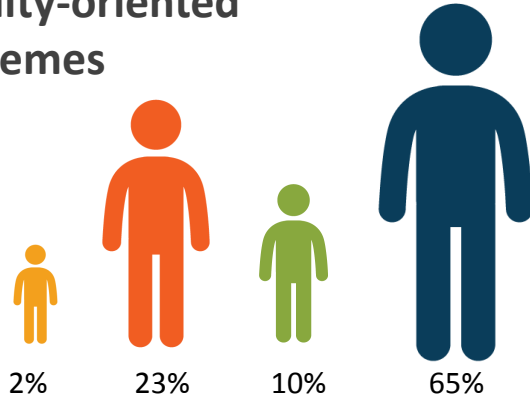
Direct investments amount to 17% of individual assets, divided as 3% from B30 and 14% from T30.



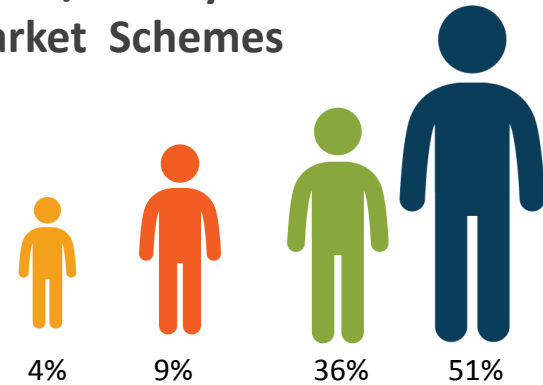

Individual Investors – Scheme level Composition

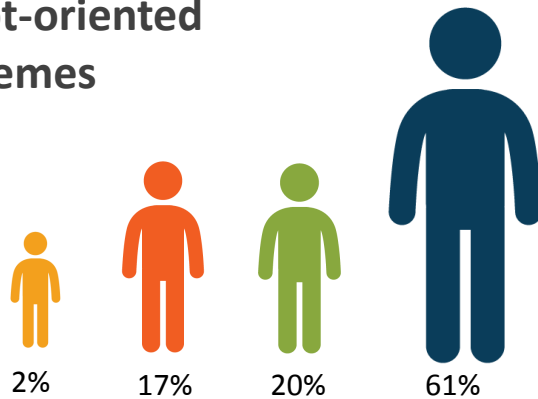

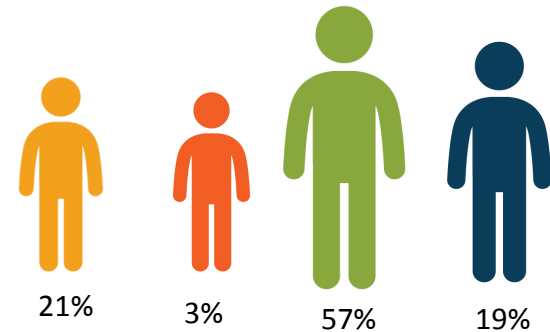
Liquid/Money Market Schemes
